

Ambassador and ED of USAID Visit Vakrangee Kendra

Ambassador and Executive Director of USAID (US Agency for International Development, Washington) along with top officials from UIDAI recently visited one of our Vakrangee Kendras to understand the usage of Aadhaar in Financial Inclusion applications in live environment.

The delegation was given a demonstration of following Aadhaar services at the Vakrangee Kendra:

- Enrollment of new Aadhaar and updation of existing Aadhaar
- Opening of new bank account using Aadhaar based e-KYC services
- Fund transfer between two bank accounts of Union Bank Of India using Aadhaar
- Banking transaction (withdrawal/deposit) in Union Bank account and to other bank account (inter-operability) through biometric enabled Micro-ATM using Aadhaar Enabled Payment System (AEPS)
- White label ATM equipped with biometric Aadhaar enabled access
