**Gaurav, Sunhit take first round honours**

**Chennai:** Gaurav Pratap Singh of Noida and Gurugram youngster Sunhit Bishnoi produced a matching six-under 66 to take the joint lead after the opening round of the inaugural India Cements Pro Championship here on Wednesday. The second half of the PGTI's 2023 season got off to a cracking start with the professionals coming back fresh from the mid-season break, delivering 45 under-par scores. While Gaurav and Sunhit grabbed the lead, there were seven other golfers within one shot of the lead in tied third at the Rs 50 lakh event being played at the TNGF Cosmo Golf Course. Gaurav, who won a title in the first half of the season after a gap of 14 years, continued his rhythm with a fine effort that featured seven birdies and a bogey.

**Indian men's football team to face Iraq**

**New Delhi:** The Indian senior men's football team has been drawn against Iraq in the semifinal of the King's Cup 2023 after the draw ceremony was conducted by the Football Association of Thailand on Wednesday. The match will take place at the 700th Anniversary Stadium in Chiang Mai, Thailand on September 7. Thailand will take on Lebanon in the other semifinal later on the same day. The winners of the 49th King's Cup semifinals will contest the final on September 10. The losers will meet in the third-place play-off. As per the draw mechanics, Iraq (as the highest FIFA-ranked team - 70th) and Thailand (as hosts and ranked 113th) were placed in separate match-ups, and drawn against the remaining two teams - India, ranked 99th, and Lebanon, ranked 100th.

**Newcastle to host friendlies for Saudi**

**Newcastle:** Saudi Arabia-owned Newcastle will host the oil-rich kingdom's national team for two friendly games in September, including against Jurgen Klinsmann-coached South Korea. The games against Costa Rica on Sept. 8 and South Korea four days later were announced Wednesday by Newcastle, whose majority owner is the Public Investment Fund that manages \$700 billion of Saudi sovereign wealth. They could be the debut games coaching the Saudi team for Roberto Mancini who unexpectedly left his job Sunday with European champion Italy. Mancini is reportedly going to take the Saudi Arabia job five months before the Asian Cup hosted by defending champion Qatar. The Saudis are drawn in a group with Kyrgyzstan, Oman and Thailand.

**WC winner Paredes returns to Roma**

**Rome:** World Cup winner Leandro Paredes returned to Roma on Wednesday, signing a two-year deal with the Serie A club. Paredes joins from Paris Saint-Germain for a fee of around 4 million euros (\$4.4 million) and the Argentine midfielder will wear the iconic No. 16 shirt, that previously belonged to retired Roma legend Daniele De Rossi. "I never would've allowed it to happen without Daniele's permission," Paredes said. "He sent me a message to say he would be thrilled for me to wear that number." Paredes was teammates with De Rossi during his first spell at Roma. "Coming back to Roma is always a special thing, but doing so now as a Roma player is even more special," Paredes said. "I'd like to thank the fans for welcoming me and Roma for bringing me back to the club where I launched my career in Europe."

**Milan:** At the age of 71, Claudio Ranieri will have to continue working his managerial magic if newly-promoted Cagliari is to avoid going straight back down to Serie B. Ranieri has already pulled off something of a masterstroke just to get Cagliari promoted. The Sardinian team is returning to Serie A a year after being relegated, as is Genoa. The other promoted side, Frosinone, is ending a four-year absence. The odds are highly stacked against all three teams still being in Serie A at the start

**FC Goa storm into quarters**

FC Goa have cemented their spot in the knockout stages of the Durand Cup 2023, following their 3-0 win over Downtown Heroes FC in their final group stage game at the Indira Gandhi Athletics Stadium in Guwahati.

Goals by Muhammed Nemil, Carlos Martinez and Devendra Murgaokar helped the Men in Orange wrap up their Durand Cup group stage campaign with a win on Wednesday.

Earlier in the day, FC Goa coach Gouramangi Singh made as many as six changes to the playing XI that started in the recent drawn encounter against NorthEast United. Goalkeeper Hrithik Tiwari replaced Dheeraj Singh between the sticks, while new signing Jay Gupta made his debut in defence alongside Odeji Onaibia.

The opening goal of the match came in the 19th minute, and it was a moment of sheer brilliance from Muhammed Nemil that set the tone for the Goans' dominance.

Martinez orchestrated the play, deftly laying the ball off for Nemil with a cheeky backheel flick, and the 21-year-old, with a burst of pace and precision, advanced towards the goal and unleashed a thunderous strike from over 30 yards out.

Lionel Messi keeps scoring goals, and Inter Miami keeps winning games.

Messi ripped a shot from 30 yards past three Philadelphia defenders in the 20th minute that made fans who paid a record price for soccer tickets in the Philly area rejoice, and Inter Miami beat the Union 4-1 in a Leagues Cup semifinal on Tuesday night. Major League Soccer is Messi's league now. The seven-time Ballon d'Or winner scored his ninth goal in six matches with his new team in front of a crowd that pushed 20,000 fans, with ticket prices soaring past USD 1,000 on the secondary market.

There were few complaints. Certainly not from three Union season-ticket holders who ditched the home team's garb for

a night and traded it for Messi gear. Or fans that lined up for Messi jerseys - authenticity not guaranteed - and the ones hungry at a food truck for Messi fries.

Jordi Alba and Josef Martinez also scored in the first half for Miami, and David Ruiz scored in the second.
